The "J" exchange visitor program is designed to promote the interchange of persons, knowledge, and skills in the fields of education, arts, and sciences. All "J" exchange visitors, including J-2 dependents (like family members), who participate in programs that are financed in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, by an agency of the U.S. Government or by the exchange visitor's government, are subject to the Foreign Residency Requirement (*two-year home residency requirement*). All Fulbright grantees are expected to return to their home countries for at least two years at the conclusion of their grant/degree, in compliance with J-visa requirements.
